- **Nebraska Resource Project for the Vulnerable Young Child UNL-CCFL** – Lindsay Ondrak/Kelli Hauptman.

  - In 2023, Nebraska Resource Project for Vulnerable Young Children will be offering 3 trainings on Understanding and Screening for Trauma in Young Children. We will also be offering Overviews on CPP, PCIT, and COSP. See training list below.
  - If you have not seen our self-paced, free, virtual, online classroom on Understand Early Childhood Attachment, Trauma, and Development this is a great resource for parents and professionals.
- **Rooted in Relationships-** Stacy Scholten
  - **Initiative Updates-** Shared the updated Rooted Community map with TA's listed and the areas that are in planning. Working on end of the year reporting, evaluations, etc. Reminder that Rooted in Relationships is a package with two main components (pyramid Model and systems work).
    - Can send out full eval report to this group once completed.
  - **Circle of Security Parenting/Classroom (COSP/COSP-C)** – Sami Bradley
    - Finalizing our biennial COS report. Report now finalized and attached!
    - Stipends for CC providers completing classes.
    - Trying to offer COS in multiple languages.
    - There are some scholarships/funding for COS training
  - **Parents Interacting with Infants (PIWI)** – Christen Million.
    - Next Training of Facilitators is coming up on June 13th-14th from 8:30AM-12:00PM, via Zoom. Registration deadline is May 24th and registration is free.
    - We are planning a PIWI Booster for existing trained facilitators in early fall. Existing PIWI Fund Recipients will receive an additional year of funding before we open up funding requests to additional communities. 2023-2024 will be focused on building infrastructure across state.
    - Working on scheduling video taping for PIWI classes (hoping to have done this summer) to be used in trainings.
    - Almost completed with translation of documents, will be on the RiR website when done.
- **Pyramid State Leadership Team (PSLT)** – Christen Million
  - The PSLT Annual Retreat is coming up on March 31st. Registration is closed. We will welcome Dr. Ferial Pearson as she conducts a training on microaggressions for the team, then we will move into work plan updates. Most of our work recently has been focused on equity. Nebraska was asked to present at NTI about the equity work our State Leadership Team has done. This will take place in April. Nebraska was also accepted by NCPMI to receive technical assistance around suspension and expulsion.

Representatives from the PSLT will be attending Zoom sessions and personal TA for the next few months.

- NE selected by NCPMI to do TA around exclusion/suspension research/work.
- National Pyramid conference coming up in April and NE will be presenting on our work around equity.

- Head Start/Early Head Start FY 2023 Funding includes:
  - An increase of \$960 million for Head Start programs, up to \$860 million of which will be invested primarily in the workforce. This includes \$596 million for a cost-of-living adjustment (COLA) and \$262 million for quality improvement. Additionally included in the funding are three new grant competitions for expansion including a \$2 million increase for the Tribal College and University-Head Start (TCU-HS) Partnership program, \$100 million for EHS/HS expansion, and \$15 million for AIAN EHS/HS expansion.
